We are writing to let you know that a series of music events will be taking place in the Crystal Palace Park between the 7th - 12th September 2021.

Sound Checks: Sound checks will take place on each of the event days prior to opening and on Thursday 9th September. No sound checks will take place earlier than 10am Tuesday to Saturday or 11am on Sunday.

Latest Event Close: 22:00hrs (Friday - Sunday)

ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

A team of independent acoustic consultants have been appointed to monitor levels throughout the whole event to ensure that the noise from the events is controlled within the limits. On the day of each show a meeting will be held with the acoustic consultants and the organisers to discuss noise management strategy and debrief from the previous event.

We have made arrangements for additional cleaning in the local area. If you have any concerns about noise levels or litter, please contact us on the community phone line or email.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Traffic plans for Wireless Festival have been produced. We work closely with various organisations and emergency services with the aim to cause as little disruption as possible to residents and provide safe access and exit from the site. Traffic routes will be managed by Offsite Traffic Co-ordinators and marshalled by an experienced traffic management company accordingly. We welcome engagement with the local community and residents can find more information here on specific road changes and information.

In order to minimise attendees parking in the local area and maintain resident and business parking, there will be some resident access only road closures in place on the 10th -12th September. These will be accessible for residents with this letter and/or proof of address such as a utility bill. It is anticipated that these residents' access only road closures will be in place from 10:00hrs to 23:30hrs each day. They will be staffed and managed by an experienced traffic management company.

There are additional parking restrictions and bay suspensions in place to facilitate the traffic management plan. Those residents with Zone D Permits for Anerley Hill are asked to park at Ledrington Road on the 10th – 12th September. There will be a towing removal service in place on the 10th – 12th September to relocate any vehicles to Ledrington Road that are in contravention. If you are not a permit holder but reside in Anerley Hill please can you send your vehicle registration and your address to cp.residents@festivalrepublic.com no later than Wednesday 8th September so that we may pass your details on to allow you to park in Ledrington Road.

Resident Access Only Road Closures

There will also be some full road closures in order to facilitate the safe movement of pedestrians. Specific details are below:

Thicket Road - Road Closure

Thicket Road will be closed at the junction with Crystal Palace Park Road, between 10:00hrs-23:30hrs on each event day. Access for residents of Thicket Road will be maintained via the junction with Anerley Road and Anerley Park Road. The existing one-way restriction on Thicket Road will be relaxed whilst the road closure is in place.

Anerley Park – Road Closure

Anerley Park will be closed, from the junction with the High Street to the junction with Penge West station between 20:00hrs-23:30hrs on each event day. During these times, access for residents will be maintained via the junction with Anerley Road and Anerley Park Road. The existing one-way restriction will be relaxed whilst the road closure is in place.

Anerley Hill – Road Closure

Anerley Hill will be closed to traffic traveling in a south-easterly direction between 20:30hrs-23:30hrs on each event day.

Parking Restrictions

Parking restrictions will be in place on roads surrounding the park, please refer to local signage that will be installed in advance of the event for more details on localised parking restrictions.
